

Annual report(2020-21)

It is our pleasure to present the annual report of Sri Ram International School for the academic year 2020-21. Year 2020 will always be remembered as the year that gave all of us plenty of opportunities amidst the challenge we faced. For the first time we experienced remote learning in our teaching career spanning over a decade. Over a month we mastered many techniques that made remote learning sheer pleasure for the kids.

CBSE could not conduct all exams of 2019-20 batch due to the pandemic(CoVID-19) and this has happened for the first time in the history of CBSE. Our students excelled in the exams they could attempt and we can proudly showcase their results.

XII Result

Session 2019-20 was first batch of class XII humanities stream. We got good result in AISSE-2020. Our first topper Soumya got 96.4% marks, Second topper Sakshi got 95.6% marks, third topper Ritika got 94.2% marks. Out of 55 students 32 students got distinction(scored above 75% marks). It is possible only because of our mutual teamwork and hard work of the staff, the students and whole hearted support of management.

X Result

In session 2019-20, we got very good results as always. Our first topper Paras got 97% marks, second topper Tanya got 94.6% marks. Third topper Khushboo got 93% marks. Out of 155, 20 students scored above 90% marks, 40 students scored more than 80% marks, 92 students got distinction(scored more than 75% marks). It was possible only because of our hardworking teachers and sincere students and the support of the school management.

Following is brief review of the performance of the school:

- a.) April 1, 2020 : Sri Ram International School started remote learning on zoom platform. For the first time, the classes were meticulously planned with well designed curriculum and structured time table. Our teachers gave individual attention to the students in solving their problems and difficulties.
- b.) We have successfully implemented the changes in the assessment policy as per the CBSE guidelines 2020-21.
- c.) CBSE opened their online training portal for the teachers to attend and complete their compulsory training mandated by the CBSE, like competency based learning on DIKSHA portal ,blended learning etc.
- d.) We conducted all our exams on online mode like periodic tests, half yearly exams, pre boards and annual exams on online mode with the help of Google classroom and Testmoz app and performance of our students in periodic, half yearly and annual examination was good.
- e.) We have conducted online competitions in arts, sports, music and dance. We virtually celebrated Independence Day, Teachers' day, Diwali, Christmas and New Year. We celebrated Rastriya Ekta Divas and Constitution Day on 26th November, Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat program on 7th December on online mode.
- f.) We also provided remedial classes for underperforming students after school, where our teachers solved the problems of students.

g.) We conducted online self defence training program for the safety of girl students and the achievers were awarded certificates.

h.) The Fit-India freedom run was successfully conducted and received a prestigious certificate from the ministry of youth affairs of India.

i.) We followed all the norms of safety, health and security as per the CBSE guidelines.

We are waiting for the next academic year, we will bring in a lot of good programs, activities, training and will conduct here for children to develop their physical. Emotional, spiritual and mental health in accordance with their age and standard.
